Your child's learning journey charts the progress they make in all areas of development whilst at pre-school. It....

- Charts your child's learning and development.
- Celebrates your child's strengths and special moments.
- Provides information to support Progress Summaries.
- Alerts us to areas of development which may require extra support.
- Helps us to plan exciting and stimulating activities and experiences using the child's interests.

We value your contribution. This will help us gain a mutual understanding of your child's learning. You can help us by..

- Looking through the learning journey with your child and discussing it together.
- Adding your own comments to the observations made by pre-school staff in your child's learning journey.
- Sharing any thoughts or comments about your child's learning/learning journey with their key person.
- Adding your own photos or comments of what activities/outings or special moments and family events your child has experienced at home.
- Taking a moment to fill out 'knowing me' sheets to enable us to update our knowledge on your child's current interests (to be issued on a regular basis).

You may take your child's learning journey home at any time, however, it must be signed out- and in again on return (please see a member of staff).
